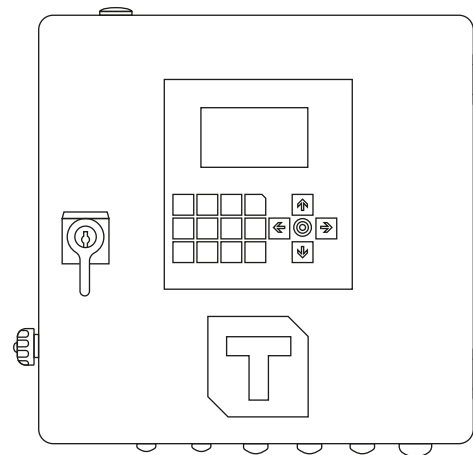


# WONDERBOX HD Manager Re-Setup

## 1. Install a new copy of HD Manager 8 if not already installed.

### 2. Adding Fuel Terminal(s):

- Click on the Master Data tab.
- Click on HDA in the green bar.
- Click on the Fuel Terminal tab.
- Click "New" on the bottom right.
- In the "Identifier" field type the name you would like to call your Wonderbox.
- In the "Type" field drop down the box so it reads "HDA eco (Wonderbox)"
- In the "Communication" dropdown, select "USB Flash Drive"
- Click the "Save" button on the bottom right.
- If adding multiple terminals, repeat steps d-h as needed.



### 3. Setting Product Names:

- In Master Data -> HDA, click on Delivery Point.
- If you have multiple terminals, click the terminal you want to edit settings for in the bottom bar (blue highlight when selected).
- At the right-hand side, click the product number you want to assign to this Wonderbox.
- In the "Product name" and "Displayed name" fields, type in the product name being dispensed, then click save.
- At the left side, use the up and down arrow keys next to Product Name to match the product to the Wonderbox. Click Save on the left when finished.
- Repeat steps b-e for additional terminals as needed.

### 4. Importing Code List:

- Plug your USB drive into your computer.
- Click on the Data Import tab.
- Click on Data Import in the green bar.
- Under the Import Data tab, click Select File.
- In the window that opens, select the USB drive, then select the Wonderbox's serial number (7 digits starting with a 2).
- Select the DATAOUT.TXT file, then click Open.
- Select the Fuel Terminal being imported from.
- Click Import Data. When finished, the number of Imported drivers and vehicles should be shown.

### 5. Importing Transaction History:

- Plug your USB drive into your computer.
- Click on the Data Import tab.
- Click on Data Import in the green bar.
- Under the Import Data tab, click Select File.
- In the window that opens, select the USB drive, then select the Wonderbox's serial number (7 digits starting with a 2).
- Select the DATA####.TXT file (first file is DATA0001), then click Open.
- Select the Fuel Terminal being imported from.
- Click Import Data. When finished, the number of imported transactions should be shown by Fueling Data.
